AFFIDAVIT OF JAMES RICHARD FLETCHER

1. My name is James Richard Fletcher. I am more than 18 years old, have never been convicted of a felony or crime involving fraud or moral turpitude. I am fully competent to make this Affidavit.

2. All of the facts set forth herein are true and correct. All of the facts set forth herein are within and based on my personal knowledge.

3. I am a resident of Colleyville, Tarrant County, Texas and an opponent of the Glade Road proposition that has been a local issue both before and during the most recent city council election cycle. This lawsuit relates to events surrounding that election, which took place on May 9, 2015.

4. At a meeting on April 29 at Worthington National Bank regarding the Glade Road project, I received part of a transcript of Bobby Lindamood Jr.'s deposition dated March 4, 2011 in the lawsuit, *In re: Estate of Bobby Lindamood [Sr.]*, Cause No. PR093184-1 in Probate Court No. 1 of Dallas County, Texas. Michael Taylor had distributed the copies of the transcript. Some

of the text had been highlighted, but it had no annotations, underlining, deletions, or comments in the margins. I had to leave the meeting before it concluded.

5. The "Alert" is the annotated and underlined version of the deposition testimony I saw. Plaintiffs attached the Alert to their Petition in this case.

6. I did not make the Alert.

7. I did not author the Alert.

8. I did not publish the Alert to any other person.

9. I did not edit the Alert or the deposition of Bobby Lindamood.

10. I did not discuss the Alert with anyone.

11. I did not promote the Alert.

12. I did not endorse the Alert.

13. I did not hand out, hand-deliver, or mail the Alert.

14. I did not direct or work with any person to take any actions listed in Paragraphs 6-13 above with regard to the Alert.

15. The Alert arrived at my house on May 4, 2015 but I did not view it until May 8, 2015 because I was out of town.

16. I do participate on the Nextdoor.com forum for Colleyville under the moniker "Riverwalk."


17. I did state as a matter of my opinion that Colleyville should not elect a sexual predator. I based that comment on the excerpts of Mr. Lindamood's deposition that I had read that included a description of him in a situation with a prostitute and included a description of him putting his hands on the breasts and hip of a female who was not his wife at a time when he

was married. I had no reason to believe that the events described in the transcript were untrue because I know that depositions are sworn testimony.

18. I did post a question to Nextdoor.com forum readers: “Integrity, accountability not an issue?” In that forum thread, I stated that Colleyville should not vote for “ethical uncertainty.” Based on the events described in the transcript, I believed that a married man who placed his hands on the private anatomy of a woman who is not his wife acted improperly and worried that such a person on Colleyville’s City Council could act unethically.

Further the affiant sayeth not.


