GLADE ROAD ACCIDENTS ARE UP 31% SINCE 2013

GLADE ROAD FAST FACTS:

- ▶ Glade Road is "Unforgiving" in several areas. Making a wrong move at the wrong time will leave no options to safely avoid a wreck.
- Glade Road has been a "Neighborhood Collector" of residential roads, streets and driveways on maps dating back to 1914.
- ► The narrow 20 foot sections of Glade Road are serious public safety concerns – Glade Road is now less than 2/3rds of the standard side street width of 31 feet. By bringing the road up to standard width, our Fire, EMS and Police can quickly respond even during rush hour times.
- Reported Glade Road accidents are up over 31% since 2013 with many accidents going unreported to avoid increased insurance rates.
- Our residents cannot walk, jog, or bike safely along sections of Glade Road which have no sidewalks on both sides. Our children cannot safely walk to school.
- ▶ Colleyville has sufficient Right-of-Way to do this project without any Eminent Domain purchases. The bar ditches are within city property; City R.O.W. varies from 44' to 98', more than adequate for a standard 2lane road with sidewalks on both sides.
- ▶ The Glade Road project is proposed to be "pay-as-we-go", requiring no new taxes nor any new long-term debt. The first Glade Road section to be improved is Bransford to Manning.
- ▶ Resolution 1, as written by activists, is a flawed, overly-restrictive law that, if passed by voters, prevents the Glade Road improvements that were unanimously approved by Council from Bransford to Manning.
- ▶ We are Colleyville Taxpayers, informed enough to know that Resolution 1 is "Bad Law" and we DON'T need to "Pass it to see what's in it!"
